

What is the Community Investment Tax Credit (CITC)?

The Massachusetts CITC provides a 50% state tax rebate for donations to the Franklin County CDC of \$1,000 or more. Individuals, businesses, nonprofits, and out-of-state residents can all take advantage of this program.

Why CITC?

As a donor, you are receiving a considerable tax benefit while making a charitable investment! As a CITC donor, you are providing essential, flexible funds for the Franklin County CDC to develop new programs, expand current services, and fill funding gaps.

How does it work?

- Make a donation of at least \$1,000 to the Franklin County CDC online or by sending a check to Franklin County CDC, 324 Wells Street, Greenfield, MA 01301.
- Franklin County CDC creates an online account in Massachusetts CITC system and you receive an email to log in.
- You fill out a quick and easy online form that takes approximately 5 to 8 minutes.
- Franklin County CDC verifies your form.
- You receive a certificate 4 to 6 weeks after you submit your portion of the form that you will file with your state taxes.

If you are not a Massachusetts resident, you will receive a check in the mail from the state for the amount of your tax credit.
